# Standardizing immunophenotyping for the Human Immunology Project

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On page 195 of the original version of this article, under the subheading “NK cells”, there was an error in the following sentence: “The vast majority of peripheral blood NK cells are CD16<sup>+</sup>CD56<sup>low</sup>, whereas a smaller subset is CD16<sup>+</sup>CD56<sup>hi</sup>”. This sentence should read: “The vast majority of peripheral blood NK cells are CD16<sup>+</sup>CD56<sup>hi</sup>, whereas a smaller subset is CD16<sup>+</sup>CD56<sup>low</sup>”. In line with this, in Figure 2 on page 194, the two NK cell populations in the bottom right-hand corner (which were originally labelled as CD56<sup>low</sup> and CD56<sup>hi</sup>) should be labelled as CD16<sup>+</sup> and CD16<sup>−</sup>; the CD16<sup>+</sup> NK cells in the original figure should be labelled as CD56<sup>+</sup> NK cells.
