

A Note on My Micro Calcium Method.

Recently I published "A New Colorimetric Method for the Determination of Calcium with 0.1 c.c. of Blood."¹⁾

In this article a few words were left out at the top of 6th line of page 356. Instead of "Put about 5 grms. of seignette salt in 100 c.c. of 1% pure calcium.....," the line should begin: "To 2.5 liters of distilled water put about 5 grms. of....." If 2.5 liters of water are not added, the precipitates will occur before o-oxyquinoline solution is added.
